COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Minister's Report:

Rev. Jeff Chant reported that:

- As part of his regional responsibilities, he is the supervising Minister of the Caledonia Pastoral Charge. He sits on the Regional Future Directions Committee.
- Rev. David Hart has accepted a term contract with the United Church in Bible Hill. This will create opportunities for collaboration and support of each other. Plans are currently underway for a music workshop regarding the role of music in worship.
- The Way Forward Committee will be sharing the results of the survey with the congregation on Sunday. With the Finance Committee, they are discussing the possibility of doing an "Every Person Visitation".
- The Re-Development Committee will meet once Sam Elsworth returns from his travels. The Terms of Reference have been established.
- The Memorial Committee has distributed information to committees to determine any needs that they have that could be addressed by that Committee.
- The Worship Committee held a retreat to look at what makes "vital" worship. There will be ongoing changes to the "Order of Service". Rev. Jeff would like to see a lot more music included.
- Another Council Retreat will be planned to look at the following: Re-Development, Missions, Worship and Finance.

<u>Motion</u>: Richard Greek/Bev Burgess that Council support, in principle, to hold an "Every Person Visitation" to occur before summer. **Motion Carried.**

Ministry & Personnel Committee:

Marg Forbes advised that the Committee requires additional members as it is down to two persons.

Property Committee:

Randall Knox reported that there has been no success in securing someone to shovel snow this winter. It was agreed by consensus that, for the time being, a contractor be hired at \$32 per hour or more.

He questioned who is responsible for liaison with the Scout Committee. According to the Governance Handbook, the Members at Large have this role.

Communications Committee:

Rev. Jeff Chant advised that the Committee is working on an introductory video about who we are. They are planning to work on the website and on "Church in 20".

Inclusivity Committee:

Rev. Jeff advised that:

- The Committee needs a new Chair as Laurel Cowie has stepped down.
- Plans are underway for January 26, 2020 which is our Anniversary for Inclusivity.
- A "Lunch & Learn" workshop re inclusiveness is planned for January.
- The BUC Quilters have made hangings for the Sanctuary from tartan donated by the LGBTQ community.
- The Committee has decided to purchase a flag and gradually introduce it over the next year.
